Your membership dues will remain the same up to and including 2020, as approved by the 2016 World Conservation Congress.

Please find attached the statement of account for 2019 detailing the amount due for 2019, any credit remaining following payment of the deposit, and the final balance (positive or negative) for 2019. As per Article 24 of the IUCN Regulations, the membership dues shall become payable on the first day of each calendar year and invoices are prepared and dispatched during the last quarter of the preceding year. Please always quote your Member ID when sending payment.

IUCN membership does not expire, unless the IUCN Member is withdrawn or expelled from IUCN as detailed in Article 13 of the [IUCN Statutes](#), or unless the IUCN Member withdraws voluntarily by providing IUCN with written notification of its intention to withdraw its membership. Members withdrawing from the Union must ensure that all outstanding membership dues have been paid, up to and including the year of the notification of withdrawal.


